The 2015 Sivi Pinot Grigio Época was aged for 24 months in 50% new French oak (the rest, three years old). It comes in at 13.7% alcohol. It handles its wood beautifully. It seems substantial, precise and focused, not quite as lively as a wholly unoaked version but still very fresh and perfectly balanced. It fills the mouth and ends with some tension. This is beautifully done. The winery says that this can hold for some 10+ years. It might well. It might even be entitled to an uptick in score if it develops and improves along the way. Either way, it's a fine bargain. While you can age this, it will drink very nicely this summer too.
